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Hi,

It's been a while since I last wrote. I think it was when we had the End of Bolt Sale. You all kept me very busy that weekend. It was a very popular sale and I will definitely be running it at some time again in the future.

## CLASSES

Don't forget we always have our **ANYTHING GOES** (\$15) with Karen (second Tuesday and third Sunday of the month) and **LETS MAKE QUILTS** (\$20) with Donna (fourth Wednesday of the month) running all year long. Great if you need some motivation or help with a project and just good fun stitching with the other ladies. It is always an interesting class as everybody is doing their own thing. Class duration is 3 hours, starting at 10am. On Sundays, we start at 10:30 (so I can have a little sleep-in).

**BUNNYCUP (Machine) EMBROIDERY**, with Donna, is held the first Wednesday of each month, starting at 10:00am for 3 hours. Fee \$30 per class.

Donna is going to run her very popular **MACHINE QUILTING** Class again before the end of the year. Join us over 2 Saturday mornings to master the basics of both straight line (walking foot) and free motion quilting. Class will start at 10am and last for 3 hours. Dates are Nov 7 and Nov 21. Fee is \$70 for 2 mornings.

Sandy is going to do some more **GOLDWORK** for us. She has three new projects - Golden Lotus, Cornflowers and a Christmas Stocking. Of course you can always do any of Sandy's goldwork projects in her class. These classes run in blocks of three, for 2 hours each class.

If you'd like to try your hand at **STUMPWORK**, then Sandy has 2 new projects for you, Enchanted Forest or Christmas Holly. They incorporate many different techniques including detached elements, needle lace, wire work and more. These classes run in blocks of three, for 2 hours each class.

Dates for both of Sandy's classes are Oct 8, Oct 22 and Nov 12. You'll be finished in time for Christmas to display or give as a gift. Fee is \$75 for a series of 3 classes (Goldwork or Stumpwork).

Have you ever wanted to try your hand at **BRAZILIAN EMBROIDERY**? Cathy Sotiriou joins us this term to start you on your Brazilian journey. She has designed a beautiful embroidery to show you the basics of Brazilian and how to master bullions. This is a 1 day class (6 hours tuition), starting at 9:45am, on November 18. Fee is \$70 for the day.

Lynette has designed a new quilt featuring 6 **HAND APPLIQUE** blocks. These blocks are designed to help you progress with your hand applique skills. There are 6 classes, on a Saturday morning, each for 2.5 hours, starting at 10am. Dates are Oct 3, Oct 17, Oct 31, Nov 14, Nov 28 and finishing on Dec 12. Fee is \$150 for the 6 classes.

Please ensure you book in advance as classes fill quickly. All classes require a deposit of 50% of the cost. No refunds will be given for cancellations (by you) within 2 weeks of the class date but you may send someone else in your place. If we cancel the class, then of course you would receive a full refund of your monies.
